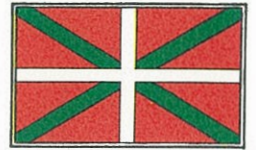

The first officers and board of directors were John Aguirre, President; Joe Urriola, Vice President; Marguerite Aguirre, Treasurer; Jennie Kendall, Secretary and Board members Louie Urriarte, Albert Samper and Lenore Holbert.

Dances and picnics were held annually until 1964. In 1964, which was the Nevada Centennial Year, the club sponsored the First National Basque Festival. This event was held on two days. The first festival was a tremendous success, and was acclaimed one of the outstanding Centennial events. Each succeeding year has seen the Festival grow in popularity.

Over 50 children enrolled for these lessons and these children will perform at the games and contests Saturday night. Members teaching the children are Ana Marie Arbillaga, Mildred Bilbao, Felisa Basanez and Mary Jane Moiola. The children have worked very hard and their interest has been most inspiring.

All committees have been hard at work to make this year's Festival a success. At this time the Basque Club would like to express their gratitude and appreciation to the many local and out of town people who have supported them wholeheartedly in this undertaking. The Club sincerely hopes to see each and everyone of you again in 1969.

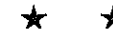
